

Visegrad Film Forum will organise master classes and workshops on **Low-budget Film Production**

2nd year of an international event Visegrad Film Forum (VFF) will take place at **the Film and Television Faculty of the Academy of Performing Arts on 17th – 20th of October 2012 in Bratislava, Slovakia**. This year VFF comes up with master classes and workshops focusing on **Low-budget Film Production**. The events are open to everyone, from film students and professionals to general public interested in film or willing to learn some more about it. All of the lectures will be run by film professionals coming from different European countries.

VFF audience will also have a chance to meet students of the hosting Academy of Performing Arts as well as students of partner universities like **FAMU in Prague, SZFE in Budapest, PWSFTViT in Lodz, AGRFT in Ljubljana and UNATC in Bucharest**.

The general ambition of the VFF is to support the collaboration between film students and graduates coming from the Central and Eastern European region, create favourable working conditions for them, share the practical information on international film coproduction and the low-budget film production through their general phases.

2nd year of VFF will be thematically linked on its previous 1st year, which hosted outstanding European film personalities such as the Berlinale winner **Benedek Fliegauf**, Polish film legend **Krzysztof Zanussi**, provoking Czech documentary filmmakers **Vít Klusák** and **Filip Remunda** as well as internationally recognised Slovak director **Peter Kerekes**.
